Sponsors John Buckley and Mary Buckley, none of whom could sign. John Brady, priest.
- 7 BMS Ottawa, Basilique Notre-Dame, On the twenty-sixth of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty one, we the undersigned priest have baptized Lewis born on the first of April of last year lawful child of Lewis Burns and of Mary-Ann Wallace. Sponsors: Joseph Vezina and Ellen Tompkins. D. Dandurand, priest.
