1. **ANTOINE¹ MORIN** was born on 04 Apr 1820 in Ste-Marie-de-Beauce, Québec¹. He died on 13 May 1905 in Cumberland Township, Ontario²⁻³. He married Emélie Payment dite Larivière, daughter of Jean Baptiste Paiement dit Larivière and Marguerite Laduranté, on 18 Aug 1846 in St. Jean Baptiste, L'Original⁴⁻⁶. She was born on 29 Oct 1825 in Vaudreuil, Québec⁷. She died on 12 Aug 1896 in Cumberland Township, Ontario⁸.

Antoine Morin and Emélie Payment dite Larivière had the following children:

- i. **ANTOINE² MORIN⁹** was born on 05 Apr 1847 in Hawkesbury, Ontario¹⁰. He died on 13 Sep 1847 in Hawkesbury, Prescott, Ontario, Canada¹¹.
- ii. **MELIA MORIN¹²** was born on 15 May 1849 in Hamilton Mills, Hawkesbury, Ontario¹³⁻¹⁴. She died on 11 Feb 1927 in Cumberland, Ontario¹³. She married John Moffatt, son of Robert Moffatt and Catherine Johnston, on 27 Sep 1865 in Ottawa, Ontario¹⁵. He was born on 03 May 1837 in Ireland¹⁶. He died on 21 Sep 1923 in Cumberland, Ontario^{13, 17}.

She married Joseph Giroux, son of Henry Giroux and Sophie Laviolette, on 15 Sep 1873 in Sainte-Félicité, Clarence Creek²¹. He was born on 27 May 1851 in Lochaber Township, Québec²². He died on 22 Aug 1937 in Rockland, Ontario²³.
- iv. **HÉLÈNE MORIN** was born on 18 Jul 1852 in Cumberland, Ontario²⁴⁻²⁵. She died on 03 Jun 1936 in Navan, Ontario²⁶. She married Magloire Damour, son of Antoine Damour and Luce Nantel, on 14 Feb 1871 in Sainte-Félicité, Clarence Creek²⁷. He was born on 12 Jul 1839 in Laval, Québec, Canada²⁸. He died on 04 Aug 1928 in Sarsfield, Ontario²⁹.
- v. **PHILIPPE MORIN** was born on 06 Feb 1854 in Cumberland Township, Ontario³⁰⁻³¹. He died on 06 May 1932 in Cumberland Township, Ontario³². He married Sarah Summers, daughter of William Summers and Margaret O'Toole, on 11 Jan 1875 in Sainte-Félicité, Clarence Creek^{4, 33-34}. She was born on 15 Jan 1856 in Lochaber Township, Québec³⁵. She died on 30 May 1929 in Cumberland, Ontario³⁶.
- vi. **MARIE MORIN** was born on 28 Feb 1856 in Cumberland, Ontario³⁷⁻³⁹. She died on 03 Dec 1935 in Ottawa, Ontario^{17, 40}. She married Antoine Leduc, son of Antoine Leduc and Joseph Leduc, on 24 Jan 1875 in Sainte-Félicité, Clarence Creek⁴¹. He was born on 19 Aug 1837 in St-Timothée, Beauharnois, Québec⁴²⁻⁴³. He died on 29 Jun 1907 in Gloucester, Ontario⁴⁴⁻⁴⁵.
- vii. **ANTOINE ÉPIPHANE MORIN** was born on 07 Jan 1858 in Cumberland Township, Ontario⁴⁶. He died on 19 Apr 1859 in Cumberland Township, Ontario³⁴.
- viii. **ANONYMOUS MORIN** was born on 06 Apr 1859 in Cumberland Township, Ontario³⁴. Anonymous died on 07 Apr 1859 in Cumberland Township, Ontario³⁴.
- ix. **GEORGES MORIN** was born on 28 Apr 1860 in Cumberland, Ontario⁴⁷⁻⁴⁸. He died on 23 Feb 1866 in Cumberland, Ontario⁴⁹.
- x. **SAMUEL MORIN** was born on 16 Aug 1861 in Cumberland, Ontario⁵⁰⁻⁵¹. He married Cary Vina Leblanc on 13 Mar 1892⁵².
- xi. **LÉOCADIE MORIN** was born on 13 Jan 1863 in Cumberland Township, Ontario⁵³⁻⁵⁴. She died on 21 May 1906 in Escanaba, Delta, Michigan, USA⁵⁵. She married Adolphe (Delphis) Chabot, son of Jean-Baptiste Chabot and Marie Sénécal, on 17 Aug 1883 in Ottawa, Ontario⁵⁶⁻⁵⁷. He was born on 10 Jun 1864 in Papineauville, Papineau, Quebec, Canada⁵⁸.
- xii. **NAPOLÉON MORIN** was born on 20 Sep 1864 in Cumberland, Ontario⁵⁹⁻⁶⁰. He died on 01 Jul 1933 in Cumberland Township, Ontario. He married Anna Riopel, daughter of Calixte Riopel and Émilie Corbeil, on 29 Apr 1889 in Très Ste-Trinité, Rockland, Ontario. She was born on 10 Mar 1870 in Ste-Scholastique⁶¹. She died on 13 Apr 1943 in Navan, Ontario⁶².

- xiii. JOSEPH MORIN was born on 19 Jun 1866 in Cumberland, Ontario⁶³⁻⁶⁴. He died on 01 Apr 1879 in Cumberland, Ontario⁶⁵.
- xiv. FRANÇOIS FREDERICK NELSON MORIN was born on 31 Jul 1868 in Cumberland, Ontario⁶⁶⁻⁶⁷. He died on 05 Jan 1946 in Toronto, Ontario. He married Marie Louise Sara Lemay dite Delorme, daughter of Siméon Lemay dit Delorme and Cédulie Patry, on 06 Apr 1891 in Sainte-Félicité, Clarence Creek⁶⁸⁻⁶⁹. She was born on 16 May 1873 in Clarence Creek, Ontario⁷⁰. She died on 24 Jun 1936 in Orléans, Ontario⁷¹.
